

ALERTA: recientemente se ha descubierto el alga invasora *didymosphenia geminata* (moco de roca) en la Patagonia

Ayúdenos a proteger los ambientes desinfectando todos sus equipos (waders, botas, líneas, señuelos, belly boats y embarcaciones) que pueden involuntariamente dispersarla.

RETIRAR

restos de vegetación, barro, algas, sedimento y agua de los equipos y embarcaciones antes de abandonar lagos y ríos.

REMOJAR

todo lo que estuvo en contacto reciente con el agua durante al menos un minuto en un recipiente de agua con lavandina utilizando un vaso de lavandina (200 ml) cada 10 litros de agua (un balde doméstico) o en agua caliente por encima de 60°. Los equipos que absorban agua (chalecos salvavidas/m botas de vadeo, waders) debe dejarse en remojo al menos 30 minutos para asegurar su limpieza.

SECAR

si la limpieza no es posible, dejar secar totalmente los equipos al sol y esperar 48 hrs. antes de volver a usarlos en otro sitio.



CHECKING

before leaving rivers or lakes, carefully remove seaweed remains and sediments adhered to gear and boats. In case you see any remains once you have left, please remove them, and place them into trash cans, not in home sewage.

CLEANING

Whether might have been in contact with water should be soaked and rubbed for at least one minute in any of the following solutions:

- I-Leach al 2% (a small glass or 200 ml. in 10 l. of water)*
- II-Salt a 5% (salt 500 gr. in 10 l. of water)*
- III-Soak in very hot water, above 60° C. Water absorbent gear (life jackets, ford boots and waders) should be left, to ensure cleaning, in any of these solutions, for at least 30 minutes.*

DRYING

When the cleaning process is not possible. Drying is effective if material is left absolutely dry, that is to stay: when you touch it and humidity is felt in the inside or the outside. Once gear is dry, it can only be used again after, at least, two days (48 hours) have elapsed.

Do not bring used waders and wading boots to Patagonia

Our environments are free of whirling disease, mud snail, and other dangerous species. These aquatic invaders can hitch a ride on the waders, clothing, boots and other items used in waters where those species are present.

The introduction to Argentina of exotic species which could damage the ecological balance, the biodiversity and environment of streams, rivers and lakes is a violation of the Argentine Constitution and of applicable federal laws. If you are interested in fishing in Argentina, please ask your guide to provide you new or uncontaminated wading gear.
